San Mateo County Civil Grand Jury issued a report on Ransomware attacks on local governments' data infrastructure. San Mateo County strongly advises that the governing entities report on their current cybersecurity systems, backup and recovery strategies, and prevention plans in the act of cyberattacks. <u>By June 30, 2021</u>, your IT department should be providing a security report to you with actions in place and plans for enhancements to the existing cybersecurity strategy.
